REGULAR BUSINESS

1. Repeal 15-minute Parking – Malden Avenue

Consider repealing the 15-minute parking restriction on the west side of Malden Avenue, between Amerige Avenue and Commonwealth Avenue, and designate said area as 2-hour parking.

Recommendation by Engineering Staff: Approve and recommend to Council.

2. No Stopping Anytime – Chapman Avenue

Consider rescinding the existing 1-hour parking restriction on the south side of Chapman Avenue adjacent to Fullerton College, and approve the installation of "No Stopping Anytime".

Recommendation by Engineering Staff: Approve and recommend to Council.

3. Overnight Parking – Chapman Avenue

Consider a request to remove the "Early Morning Parking" restriction on both sides of Chapman Avenue between Adlena Drive and Elizabeth Way.

Recommendation by Engineering Staff: Approve "Early Morning Parking" on the south side of Chapman only and recommend to Council.

4. Request for Marked Crosswalk – Amerige Avenue

Consider a request to install a mid-block marked crosswalk on Amerige Avenue in front of City Hall.

Recommendation by Engineering Staff: Deny the request.
