REGULAR BUSINESS

1. **BICYCLE MASTER PLAN**

Members discussed Chapter 1 of the Draft Bicycle Master Plan. The following comments/corrections were recommended for the various sections of the document:

1.2 Will review this item at a later date

- 1.2.1 P2 Promote bicycling as a *viable* and valuable form of transportation.....
P3 **Bicycle Safety, Efficiency and Convenience** (change title)
Improve safety, efficiency, and *convenience* for bicyclists in Fullerton....
P4 Support *bicycling* as an integral part.....
P5 Support appropriate and innovative bicycle programs, *initiatives* and *facilities*,
such as bike boulevards, all “bike days”, “cycling events”, “road diets”
throughout Fullerton.....
P7 *Add sentence relating to all bikes being on city streets.....*
- 1.2.2 A1 Collaborate with North Orange County *cities and agencies (OCFCD, OCTA, etc)*. to maintain link, expand and promote subregional bike networks and facilities. *Delete remainder of sentence.*
A2bicycle-oriented on-street wayfinding signage, *public* access television ads
A4 *Define in more detail*
A5 Review and update the Fullerton Bicycle Master Plan as necessary *through public outreach and involvement to identify needs.*
A7 *Rewrite to make it more as setting design guidelines and development standards based on input from the community.*
A8 *Rewrite to include bicycle standards for City facilities*

- 1.5 Confirm contents of paragraph, i.e. *“funding and political support.”*
- 1.6 Change Bikeways Master Plan to *“Bicycle”* Master Plan and reference *Chapter 8.*
- 1.7 Delete Class I bike paths, Class II bike lanes and Class III bike routes and replace with *“bicycle traveling.”* Also add which *edition* for the Caltrans Highway Design Manual and the AASHTO Guide for the Development of Bicycle Facilities.

Chapter 2 was discussed briefly, but would be further discussed at the next meeting, along with Chapter 9.
