Firework Safety Tips

- Only Safe and Sane fireworks are permitted in Fullerton.
- Use allowed only on July 4th between the hours of 10am and 10pm.
- Never allow young children to play with or ignite fireworks.
- Minimum age to buy and use Safe and Sane fireworks is 16 years.
- Use only on private property with permission (no parks, schools, etc.).
- The use of fireworks should always be supervised by adults.
- Never have any portion of your body directly over any firework device when lighting the fuse.
- Light one item at a time.
- Move back to a safe distance immediately after lighting.
- Never try to re-light or pick up fireworks that have not fully functioned.
- Never throw fireworks or point them at another person.
- Keep a bucket of water or a garden hose handy in case of fire or other mishap.
- Never carry fireworks in a pocket or shoot them off in metal or glass containers.
- After fireworks fully complete their functioning, douse the spent device with plenty of water from a bucket or hose before discarding to prevent a trash fire.
- If an item does not light easily, or if it lights but seems to fizzle, stand back and do not handle for 30 minutes.
- Fireworks are prohibited to be sold or used in the High Fire Severity Zones (see map).
