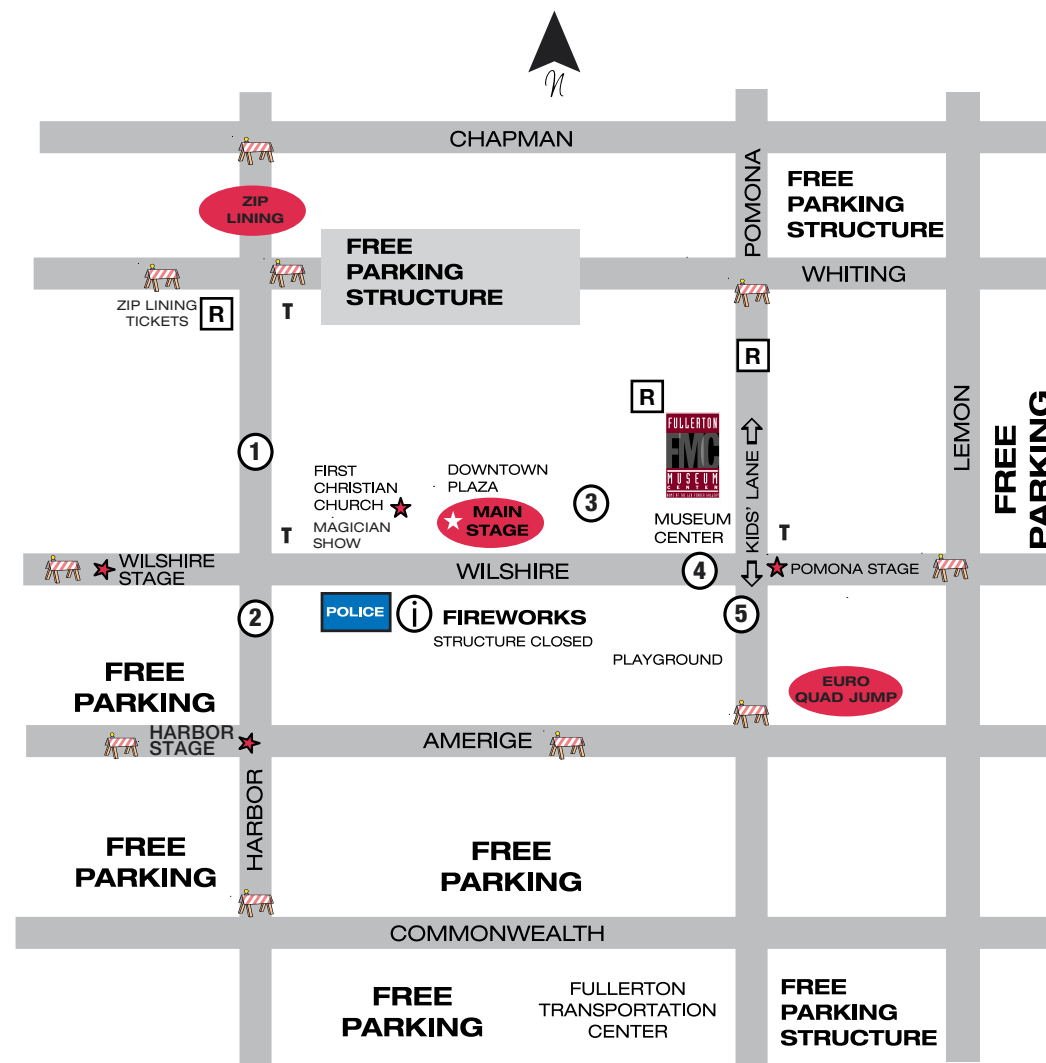

Take a new look at Leo Fender's life, work and lifetime of inventiveness during the 10 year anniversary of the Leo Fender Gallery.

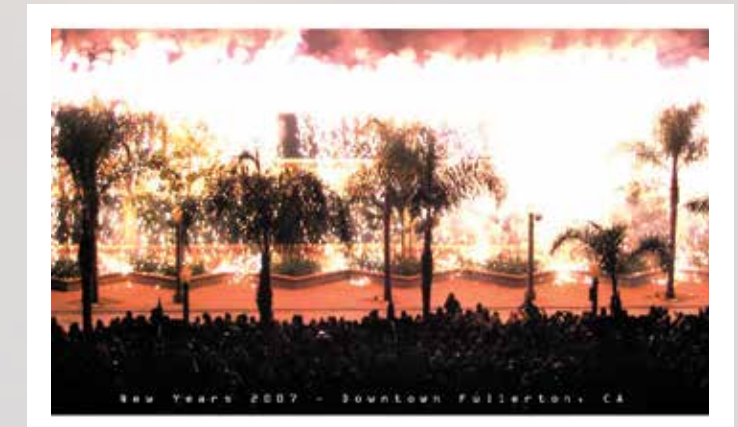
FOOD
